Will James is currently serving 680 students. With the demands of Common Core being implemented, we believe that our department could greatly benefit from our own mobile lab. The demand for technology in the classroom is increasing, and the time that we can use the other labs in school is becoming harder to schedule all the time. We believe that a shared mobile lab would make it easier for the writing process, research based projects, and non fiction websites that mirror what the Common Core is asking from us.

The English department would be using the Common Core Chromebooks for writing expository essays, narratives, and persuasive essays. The students will also use them to become more adept at publishing quality essays and research-based projects.

Our English department would also be able to use the Chromebook lab to provide our students access to free online programs such as Newsela.com. This particular program allows students the opportunity to read non-fiction current event articles on science, money, law, health and arts. After reading an article, students are then tested on their comprehension and understanding of the material. Teachers are then provided with instant information on their students progress. This aligns with Common Core, as 75% of what our students are reading needs to be non fiction.

In addition to Newsela, or students would have daily access to other programs such as Whyville, Book Adventure, Bookwink, Read Print and Book Builder. These programs in particular encourage students to read and write every day!
