Statement of Need

McKinley Elementary's population is over 70 % free and reduced. Our Homeless population sits close to 16% and at the time of this writing we have about 57 parents who have been incarcerated during the 2013/2014 school year. The teaching of social skills is vitally important for our students.

As the school counselor my goal is to visit each K-5th grade classroom once a week and present a counseling lesson. For the primary grades my lessons focus on friendship, tattling vs. telling, Personal Space, hands and feet to yourself, etc. The students and I enjoy these lessons and it gives us a common vocabulary to discuss counseling issues when they arise. The 4th - 5th grade lessons also focus on character building, with topics such as bully prevention, responsibility, courage, choices, cyber safety, making a positive difference, etc. Means of delivery for these lessons are books, videos, craft projects, etc.

During these classroom lessons for the past several years, I have had the 3rd-5th grade classes make posters and create different projects to post and perform around school to encourage the younger students to practice their newly learned social skills.

A new approach I would like to try next year would be to create videos and quick film clips with the children about the above Social Skills and Counseling classroom lessons which I could then show to the different classes.

The creation of counseling lessons will also be a beneficial tool in light of the renovation which will be taking place at McKinley. The school year of 2014/2015 will be a challenge / adventure as our school population will be divided amongst two buildings. K-2nd grades will continue on in the McKinley Building while 3rd-5th grades will be moved to the Lincoln Center. In the past we have used a buddy class system to bring our older and younger classes together in a common learning environment, however this system will not be available next year due to building logistics.

I believe the "Grade to Grade-Building to Building video Connection" project will benefit all of our K-5 students. The older students will learn as they take ownership of their video productions, while the younger grades will learn the social skill lessons directly from older children they may know from their neighborhood or school. I envision our older students possibly showing their productions during our common K-5 monthly assemblies and K-2 classroom lessons.

A minimum of eight mandatory counseling lessons are taught throughout the school year to each class. I choose to go into the classrooms more often as I believe the Counseling lessons are an important part of a student's rounded education
